**Virtual part:** 07.05.2024 from 14.00–16.00 (Estonian time).

**On-site programme:** 20.05.2024–24.05.2024, Tallinn.

On Monday we start from 12.45, the event will end on Friday by 14.30.

The full programme will be available in April 2024.

### WHO CAN APPLY?

Administrative and academic staff members from Higher Education Institutions engaged with or familiar with the work of the European Universities Alliances project at their home university. An active engagement of all participants is expected throughout the Training Week. To guarantee a realisation of the Staff Training Week, a minimum number of 15 participants in total is required.

### FEES

There is no participation fee. Travel and accommodation costs are expected to be covered by the participant via their home university Erasmus+ scholarship.
